

As a result of the 2015 Reunion being held in Baton Rouge, Louisiana and the 2013 Reunion being held on the West Coast, in San Diego, it was once again time to meet in the Eastern part of the country. After surveying several possible Host Cities, **Virginia Beach-Norfolk** was ultimately selected.

Clearly, our reunions are a family event and the Association Officers are very grateful for family members that attend and escort those shipmates who may require a little assistance. We are also very pleased with the number of shipmates who are able to attend the reunions.

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE EXTENDS ONLINE MILITARY EXCHANGE PRIVILEGES TO VETERANS

The Department of Defense announce a policy change that will extend limited online military exchange privileges to Honorably Discharged veterans of the military, as described in DOD News Release No. NR-010-17, Dated Jan. 13, 2017.

The veterans online shopping benefit will be effective this Veterans Day, November 11, 2017. While shopping privileges excludes the purchase of uniforms, alcohol and tobacco products, it includes Exchange Services' dynamic online retail environment known so well to service members and their families. The policy change follows careful analysis, coordination and strong public support.

We are excited to provide these benefits to Honorably Discharged Veterans to recognize their service and welcome them home to their military family said Peter Levine, performing the duties for the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness.



LAST of the OLD US NAVY GEARINGS OPERATING AROUND the WORLD

Have you ever given any thought as to the current status of the old US Navy Gearing Class Destroyers, that are still in service, operating in the many Navies around the globe. As we are all very much aware, a number of the Ozbourn's sister ships were either sold or given to a number of countries around the world that included Taiwan, Pakistan and Mexico.

My recent research has determined that the last of the old World War II Gearing Class Destroyers was the **USS Steinkaker DD-863**, transferred to the Republic of Mexico Navy in 1992 and renamed **ARM Neizahualcoyotl D-102**. The research determined that the **Neizahualcoyotl**, was decommissioned in 2014, and ultimately sunk as a man made reef.

Thank goodness for our many Museum Ships, as it appears that any of us that ever hoped to once again sail on a Gearing Class Destroyer are out of luck.








