





SKIPPER IN THE SPOTLIGHT COMMANDER John G. Denham USN Commanding Officer, USS Ozbourn (66-68)

Commander John G. Denham USN, was born in California December 22, 1924. He attended school mostly in San Francisco, California. He obtained officer training in the Merchant Marine as a Merchant Sea-Cadet. From 1942 to 1945 he served in transports, cargo ships and deep sea tugs in the Atlantic, Pacific and Mediterranean war zones. In March 1945, Commander Denham was graduated from the U.S. Maritime School and was assigned until the end of World War II to the U.S. Army Transport PUEBLA. In 1948, while serving in the Merchant Marine, he was commissioned as Ensign in the U.S. Navy Merchant Marine Reserve and was ordered to the fleet oiler, USS ALLAGASH (AO-97). Shortly thereafter he volunteered for destroyers and was assigned to USS BROWNSON (DD-868). He was selected for augmentation into the regular Navy in 1955 and was ordered to USS ESTERO (AKL-5) as Commanding Officer. Other sea tours include USS

TAYLOR (DDE-468), USS O'BRIEN (DD-725), and the USS OZBOURN (DD-846).

Shore duty assignments have included the U.S. Fleet ASW School, San Diego; COMCRUDESPAC Staff; and the U.S. Navy Assistant Director of the Advanced Research Project Agency Field Unit in Thailand, Office of the Secretary of Defense.

Editors Note: Captain Denham has published several books related to his service in the United States Navy. One book that would be of special interest to those of us that have served on the USS OZBOURN is titled "DD 891". The Book is roughly based on the real life exploits of the USS OZBOURN (DD-846).


