## 2017 Biennial Reunion Update

After surveying several possible Host Cities, Virginia Beach-Norfolk was ultimately selected.


## **MESOTHELIOMA UPDATE FROM GEOFF WALKER QM2 (66-68)**

I recently read "Korea Remembered" by Shipmate Charles F. Cole. Interesting, brought back memories of my time on "OZ". He mentioned all the asbestos dust coming from the water pipes during high speed maneuvering and during gunfire. I didn't think much about it then, but a few years ago, I talked to a guy who was on a tug with similar conditions. He had Mesothelioma and recommended that I get a Cat Scan. It took about four months to accomplish it through our great VA medical system here in Hawaii. I sent the results to a lawyer who my friend went through. A Radiologist said it looked okay. I talked to the lawyer and he told me that there were at least three pending cases from the USS Ozbourn and they were all from the Engineering Department involving the "Snipes". I thought that I would pass it on after reviewing the article regarding Agent Orange exposure in the last "Fireball". *(Editors Note: We are very appreciative of Shipmates like Geoff for keeping all members apprised of current events related to all of our health.)* 

### USS ZUMWALT DDG 1000 IN THE NEWS, "CANNOT AFFORD TO FIRE ITS NEWEST PROJECTILE"

One of the newest ships in the U.S. Navy's arsenal, the USS ZUMWALT DDG 1000, a stealth guided missile destroyer cannot afford the \$80,000.00 price tag for each of it's 115 millimeter Long Range Land Attack Projectile.
