IUST A REMINDER

MILITARY EXCHANGE PRIVLEDGES TO ALL VETERANS

As a reminder to All Hands, the Department of Defense policy change regarding access to Military Exchanges is now in place. As reported by **Reed Jones, Lt. (65-67)**, in the 2017 Spring Edition, the new policy affords all Honorably Discharged Veterans from all branches of the U.S. Military, that had not previously had been given this benefit, eg: Retirees, can now register for **ON-LINE** access to the various military exchanges. You may now register with the exchange to make purchases on-line. (Editors Note: I have personally registered by typing in "Military Exchange" and then follow the instructions. Once registered you may make purchases.)

BATTLE STARS


